Main image is an ink and watercolour map of St. Helena surrounded by 14 miniature pen and ink drawings of particular sites on the island: Longwood, Jamestown harbour, Deadwood POW camp, Sandy Bay with the rock formations Lot and Lot's wife, The Briars - Napoleon's second lodging, St. Paul's church, Kent Cottage - where Gen. Cronje is living, House in Jamestown where Napoleon slept first, House of the magistrate, Broad Bottom POW camp, "Plantation" - house of the Governor, Napoleon's tomb, Jacob's ladder in Jamestown, St. Matthew's church with Diana Peak behind it.
